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APEX

Summer school will be offered through APEX virtual learning which allows students to take almost any history, English, math, or science credit for initial credit. This is a good option for students who failed a class with lower than a 60 for the year. Initial credit courses will receive the actual grade earned through completion.

* English 1, Algebra I, Biology I, and US History initial credit courses will require a state mandated EOC test which counts as 20% of the student's final grade.

Classes offered for a reduced fee: *School Option for APEX*

APEX courses are not in compliance with NCAA.

*Students may bring their lunch or choose to participate in the school lunch program hosted by the school. The program is at no-cost to students. Students will not be allowed to leave campus.

Money orders and cashier's checks will be the only form of payment accepted. Cash and personal checks will not be accepted.

Credit Recovery

Credit recovery is an opportunity for students who scored between a 60 and 69 in a core content class, to earn a 70 in place of their failing grade. Credit Recovery courses do not require EOC testing. Credit Recovery courses are not recognized by NCAA.

ACVA

ACVA is offering Keyboarding and Computer Applications for Initial Credit. Each course is a ½ credit and the courses can be taken together for a full credit. After registering at the school, the student will need to create a student account on virtualsc.org. Student will begin the course through virtualsc.org on June 13th. ACVA courses are the only summer courses designed for the student to work at home. If the student will need to participate in a school lab setting, there will be a school lab fee.

Disclaimers

Initial credit courses will be assigned a certified teacher. All regular school rules will apply during summer school. If a student is removed from summer school due to behavior issues, a refund will not be granted. Class availability is based upon enrollment. Lack of enrollment will result in classes being cancelled.
